Assignment for Week 12

Make final revisions to your design for the 'Horizontal Page' for your final portfolio interface and execute CSS/HTML adding images etc.

The Remapped Page project: Find a print page that you can translate into a web page. It should have the following elements:

- logo/branding
- headline
- one or more subheads
- minimum 4 paragraphs of text
- images [if you change the images, the new images must be compatible with the page content]
- a table of contents or other list of items

Design the Remapped page with a 3 or 4-column grid so it can become an 'Adaptive Page' that reformats to **at least 3** of these sizes:

240 px layout of news item on PDA / 240-320 px /larger PDA
640-800 px medium-sized screen
800 – 1024 px large screen
1024 – 1280 px larger screen/ 1280 px wide screen

Make some xeroxes for the print page you chose and do the following:

- on a xerox or printout of your original page, mark up the page with semantic elements, breaking the content of the page into divs. **[bring to class]**
- make a diagram to wireframe the page, showing main content areas
- gather images for the page
