Assignment for Week 8: Midterm Portfolio due Week 9

- clean up your Colored Boxes Pages with good styling of fonts and border elements. You can change the background colors so that the page is more unified.

- complete the Neighborhood Documentary Page layout using em-sizing
- incorporated a fixed-position element, [i.e. non-scrolling background as in csszen #041], an opacity element/RGBA and a rounded corners box somewhere in one of your pages
- incorporate a horizontal list-based menu or a dropdown menu

Preparing the Midterm Portfolio:

1. Make an interface page [a page of links] for your ZenCSS pages.

This should just be a set of links to your midterm pages with minimal styling
We will start an actual portfolio design project on Week 10.
see the list on the worksheet for details/requirements; you have 4 pages for the midterm.

2. Update your files in your folder on Lab Share in 'from students' in the MIDTERM folder:

- a folder with your name and **inside:**
- one folder with PSDs or Ai files of your prototyping
- one folder with the HTML/CSS pages and images for your ZenCSS pages organized so each page is in a separate sub-folder with CSS and images for that page [including variations of the page design and additional images]
- include your interface page, linking to the pages in your folders and name it index.html
- Make sure your files and folders are properly organized and named.

This is your 'local' version.

3. Uploads to the Web and class folders

upload a copy of your site folder to the Web remotely with FETCH, Transmit or Cyberduck or copy over in the lab. Upload HTML, jpg, gifs ONLY [no PSDs] so your site is ONLINE. Check all of your links!
